

PORTO > BARCELOS > FERVENÇA - Gilmonde

Route Summary: Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport → Fervença, Gilmonde

Approximate distance: 50-55 km

Estimated travel time: 45 to 55 minutes, depending on traffic

Main roads:

A28 (northbound) or A3 (via Braga)

Exit toward Barcelos/Gilmonde

Local roads leading to Quinta de Fervença


Route Overview

Depart the airport via N107 or directly onto the A28

Continue north on the A28 toward Viana do Castelo, or take the A3 toward Braga

Exit toward Barcelos, then follow signs to Gilmonde

Proceed through local roads to reach Quinta de Fervença



Accesses and transports By Car

BRAGA > BARCELOS > FERVENÇA - Gilmonde

Route Summary: Braga → **Fervença, Gilmonde**

Distance: Approximately 25 km

Estimated travel time: Around 20 minutes by car

Main roads:

Take the A11 or N103 from Braga

Exit toward Barcelos

Follow local roads to Gilmonde, then to Quinta de Fervença



Accesses and transports By Alternative Transport Options

Bus (Line 106):

Direct route from **Braga** to **Gilmonde**, approx. 50 minutes

Train + Taxi:

Train from **Braga** to **Nine Station**

Short taxi ride from **Nine** to **Gilmonde** (approx. 10 minutes)

Taxi:

Direct taxi from **Braga** to **Gilmonde** takes about 18 minutes

Shooting Facilities Overview

The existing facilities supporting shooting sports and their practitioners include:

- Restrooms
- Armory
- Weapon and Equipment Control Rooms
- Changing Rooms
- Referee Rooms
- Scoring Rooms
- Ammunition and Firearms Storage Units.



Shooting Fields

The outdoor shooting fields feature a flat, horizontal terrain measuring 300 x 110 meters, with a surface of dark soil and natural vegetation.

Spectator stands are positioned at the rear, while the remaining perimeter is bordered by an earthen embankment topped with two rows of trees, ensuring both safety and environmental harmony.

Stand 1 – 50 Meters

Designed for ISSF Rifle disciplines, this range includes:

- 20 Shooting Stations
- A covered sector with a flat, non-slip surface for shooters, target line, and bullet trap
- An open-air sector with dark soil and vegetation
- Each station is equipped with a target carrier machine operated by the shooter

Stand 2 - 50 Meters

Supports simultaneous use by:

- 30 small-caliber rifle shooters or
- 36 pistol shooters
- Suitable for 25-meter competitions and firearms in Classes B and B1



10-Meter Range

Located on the ground floor of the Social Area building:

- Enclosed space of 370 m²
- 24 shooting stations
- Non-slip flooring
- Equipped with electromechanical target carriers Ideal for air rifle and air pistol disciplines with freely acquired compressed air weapons.

25-Meter Range

- Covered and uncovered sectors
- 24 shooting stations
- Each station equipped with speed shooting machines
- Designed for firearms in Classes B and B1



100-Meter Range

- Accommodates 30 users simultaneously
- Designed for Class C firearms
- Also suitable for 25 and 50-meter competitions with firearms from Classes B and B1

IPSC Dynamic Range

- 10 IPSC lanes
- Loading zones, safety areas, sales zone, office, and restrooms
- Engineered to meet high safety and functionality standards
- Versatile enough to host other short- and long-barrel shooting disciplines
- One of the few facilities of its kind in Portugal

Shooting Ranges for 2026

We have 48 shooting stations for the World Championship, 24 at 50m and 24 at 100m, connected in the athletes' zone.
